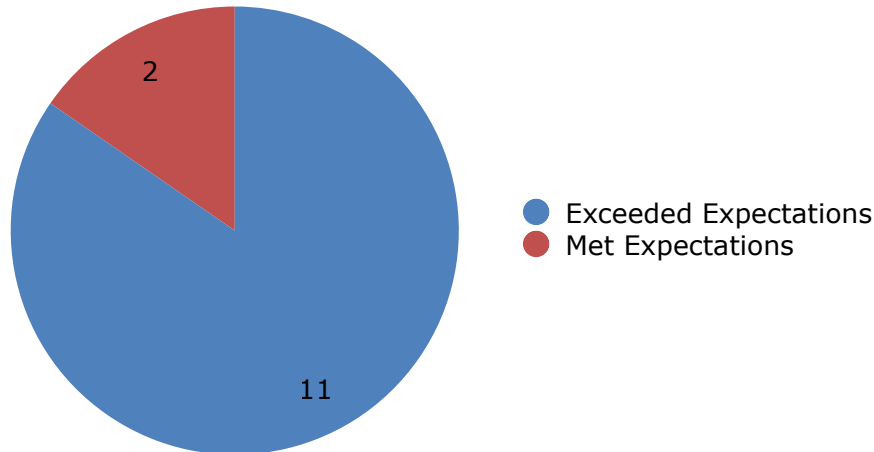

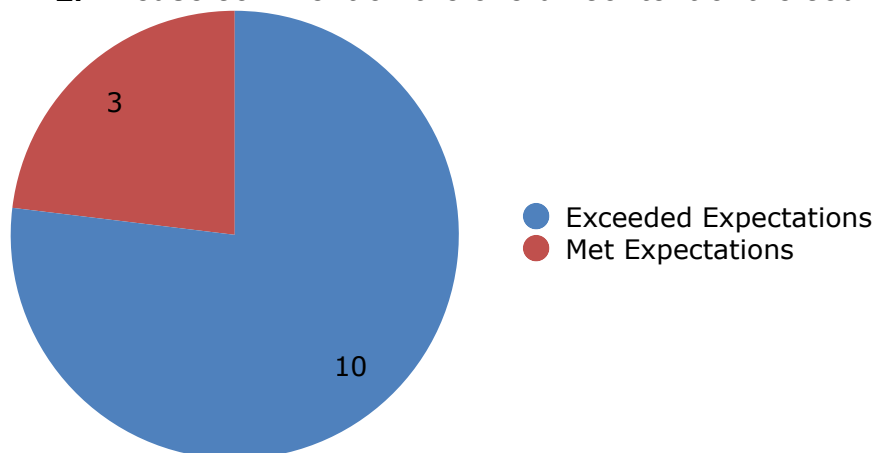
1. Please comment on how well the overall aims and objectives of the course were met

2. Please comment on the overall content of the course

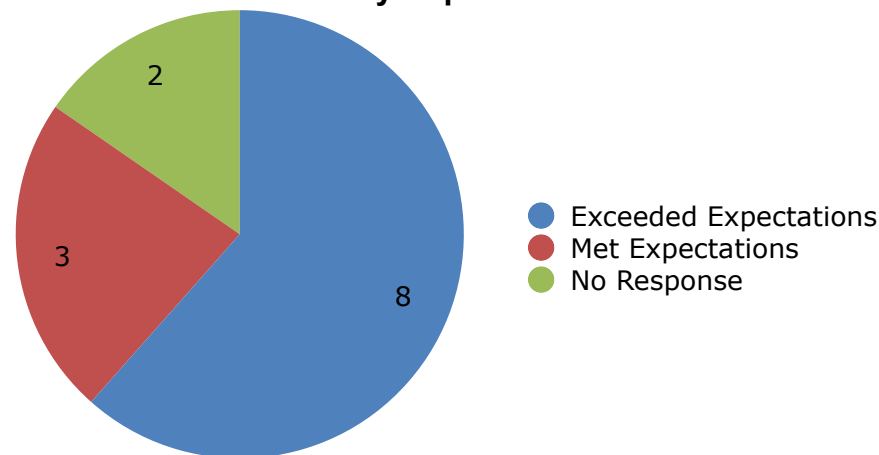

3. Please comment on the quality of the learning methods used, presentation & visual aids and handouts. Were my individual learning needs or accessibility requirements met?

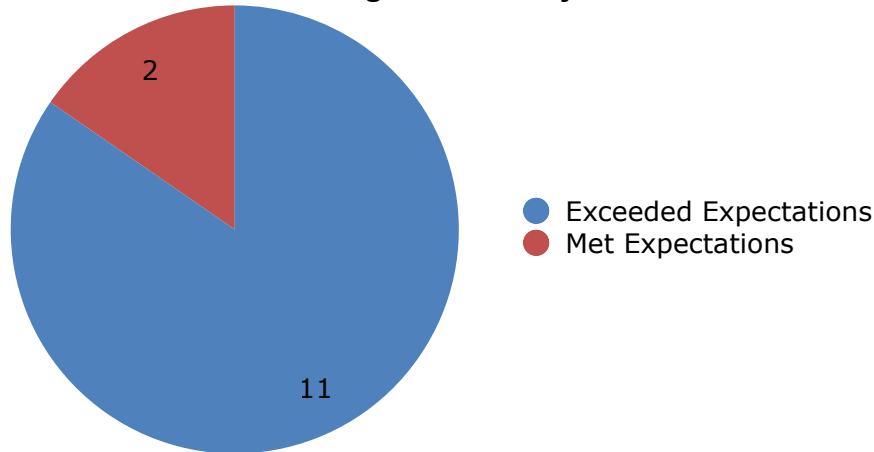

B. Course Facilitation

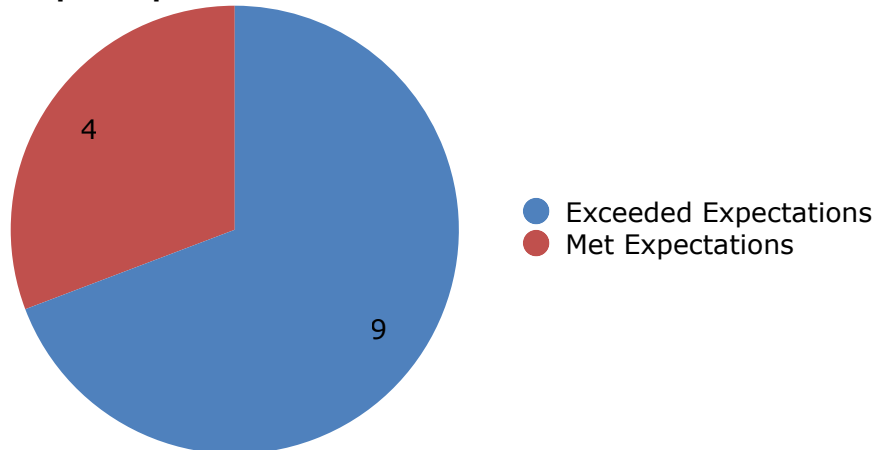
1. Facilitators knowledge of the subject area

2. The facilitators approach was effective for me and I felt encouraged to participate

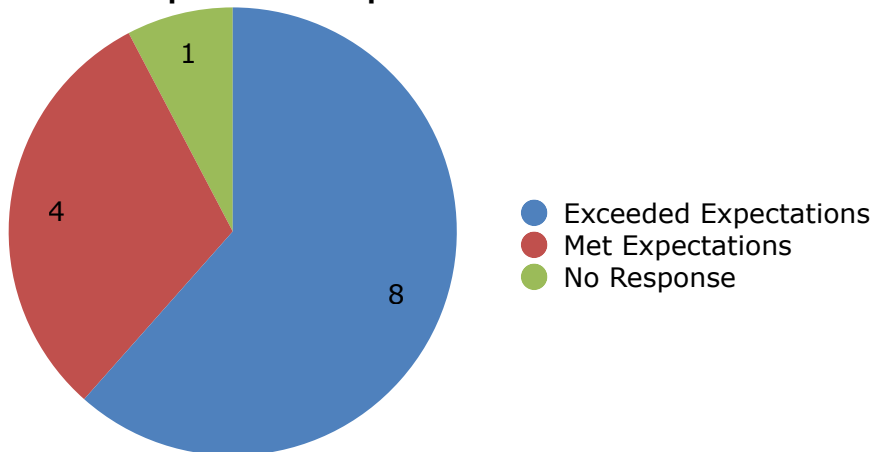

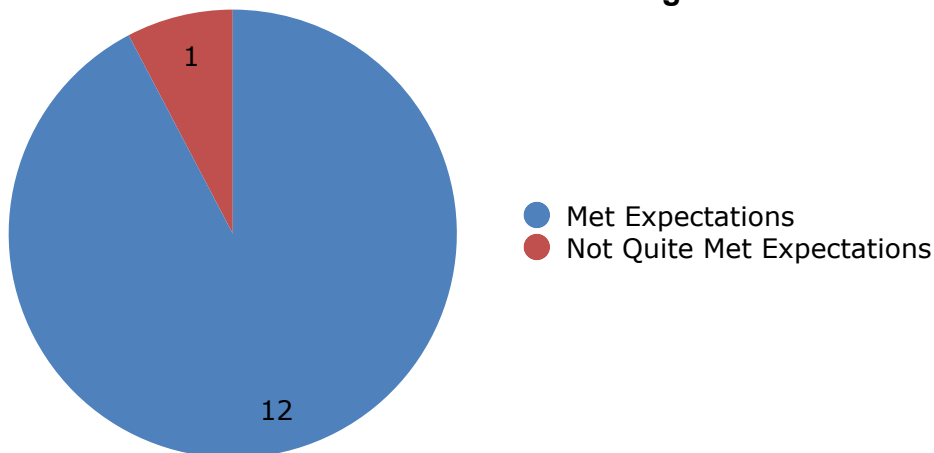
4. What is one key thing you will take into your work and practice following this course?

- Scales – using scales to help parents to make small steps

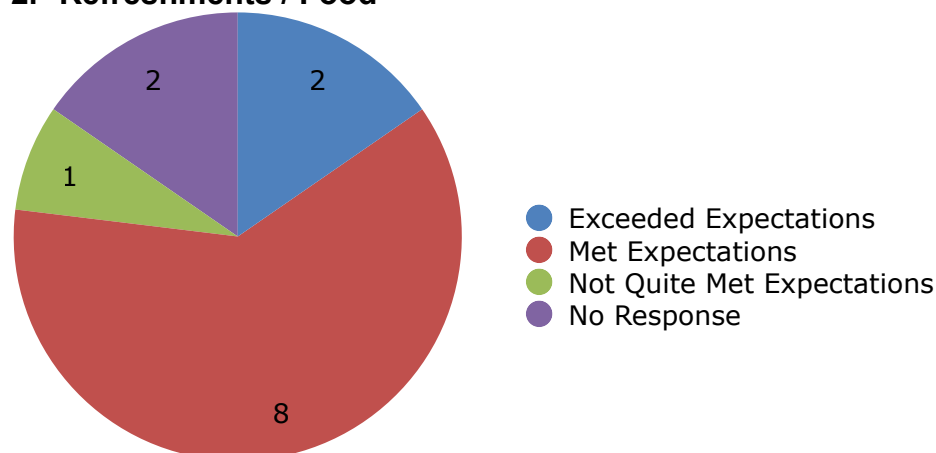
